LETTER FROM A BIRMINGHAM JAIL... by Martin Luther King Jr.



“One might well ask,” he wrote, “how can you advocate breaking some laws and obeying others?” The answer “is found in the fact that there are two kinds of laws: just laws ... and unjust laws. One has not only a legal but a moral responsibility to obey just laws,” King said, “but conversely, one has a moral responsibility to disobey unjust laws.”

How does one determine whether the law is just or unjust? A just law, King wrote, “squares with the moral law of the law of God. An unjust law ... is out of harmony with the moral law.”

MLK today would be leading the Pro Life cause to prevent abortion, the protests to protect the moral laws of God.

MLK today would be leading the protests against unjust laws contrary to the moral law of God, by his own words.

I will never forget August 1963 when this 13 year old was deeply moved by his I have a Dream speech, where he said his dream was that "his children would be judged by the content of their character instead of the color of their skin"... let that sink in that he prefaced that with "all men are created equal", so MLK today would be leading the protests against those "Leaders" pimping skin color for personal gain, touting skin color as a basis for judgement of a person's character, skills, or opportunities.
